The Fix it by Friday crew changed all of the bulbs in the chandeliers from 40-watt incandescent bulbs to LED bulbs that are equivalent to 60-watt bulbs. We had been changing one or two bulbs every couple of weeks. These new bulbs should last for years.

We have tried a number of different bulbs over the last six months, but they were either produced a single bright spot and or were not dimmable. The new bulbs reduce the amount of electricity used, produce better lighting, last longer and are dimmable.

In a weekly announce in May, we reported a special offering of \$15,000. This offering gave us income in excess of expenses on that report.

At the June Council meeting, it was decided to apply this \$15,000 to the funds that had been borrowed from the designated funds when we didn't have enough offering to cover expenses.

This resulted in a change from a positive bottom line of \$12,768 to the loss reported here.


